STALL FEES:

Annual Fee is \$25.00 per stall due by **Spring Vendor meeting or first day of Market Attendance** for a reserved space during the Market Season.

Daily Fee is \$5.00 for transient stalls with available stalls/tables to be assigned by Market Manager on first come basis. If all tables are being used, please come prepared to provide your own table. Once a transient vendor pays \$25 for the season by attending for 5 days, they are considered paid for the season, but will continue to receive stalls as available on first come basis.

Weekly BAKE SALE Fundraiser:

Vendors are requested to contribute bakery 2 times per season for our Market Table Bake Sale Fundraiser. Sign up with the Market Managers. Funds raised from this help support advertising for the Market.

The ICFM has the right to decline vendors who do not follow Market Policies or city, county, state, and federal laws. Should this occur, no refund will be issued.

All vendors must have proof of licensing available when selling products that require licensing, and are subject to inspection by Iron County Health Department. Sellers are responsible for reporting any pertinent sales or income taxes that result from their sales.

The Iron County Farmers Market is not liable for any damages that occur due to failure to follow city, county, state, and federal laws, or any other damages caused by the products sold by the seller. Sellers are responsible for following city, county, state, and federal laws, and ensuring the safety of products being sold.
